Dear Friends

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you this evening to celebrate 50 glorious years of the Zoroastrian Association of Quebec (ZAQ), the first and the oldest Zoroastrian association in North America. It all started in 1967 when a group of Zarathushtis who had settled in Montreal decided to form an Association to keep alive the ancient religion and the rich cultural heritage. We salute the pioneers for their vision and foresight. The association has been a trail blazer for many of the institutions that have been functioning on this continent.

The first publication "Gavashni" was started in 1974 in Montreal by Dr Ervad Bagli, the first president of the Association. It was a vehicle to disseminate the message of Prophet Zarathushtra to the Zoroastrian community across the North American continent. With the formation of the Federation of Zoroastrian Associations of North America (FEZANA) in 1987, it later morphed into the FEZANA JOURNAL.

In 1982 ZAQ hosted the North American Zoroastrian Congress which was a huge success. On that occasion the association compiled the Directory of Zoroastrians living in Canada, thus offering all Canadian Zoroastrians the opportunity to communicate with each other. Directories of Zoroastrians all across North America are now compiled by FEZANA, with even an electronic version available. In 1999 the North American Youth Congress was also hosted by the youth of the association with great success.

Quebec Zoroastrians continue to play leadership roles in the local, national, and international organizations. The multicultural fabric of the Canadian and Quebec societies have welcomed us with open arms and true to the Zoroastrian religion, spirit and way of life, the community has integrated into the Canadian and Quebec mosaic while retaining their identity. They serve on professional and community organizations giving their time and talent for the betterment of the country they now call HOME.

We proudly celebrate the 30th anniversary of FEZANA, 50th anniversary of our association, the 150th anniversary of Canada, the 375th anniversary of Montreal. Thank you for being with us tonight.

The Zoroastrian Association of Quebec, the first association to be established in North America in 1967 had many defining moments which were precursors to the founding of the Federation of Zoroastrian Associations of North America. (FEZANA).

The publishing of Gavashni , (editor Ervad Dr. Jehan Bagli) , the first Zarathushti newsletter of North America, distributed around the continent , the purchase of burial lots, compilation of standard procedures for funeral services , the compilation of the first American Zoroastrian Directory, the North American Congress 1982 where for the first time Non-Zoroastrians in Zoroastrian precepts were discussed.

This association launched the discussion on the standard Zarathushti calendar and prepared a compilation of opinions from across the world.

We organize events which fosters a spirit of togetherness among community members e.g. celebration of Navroz, Mehergan, Tirgan, Sadeh, Yalda, Ghambars and related Picnics. Activities are also organized to promote the teachings of the religion through religious classes for the children, adult discussion groups, participating in interfaith activities, maintaining a website and a newsletter, participate in activities organized by other Zoroastrian Associations in North America and by FEZANA.

Our Missions

The Mission of the Zoroastrian Association of Quebec is to perpetuate the religion of Asho Zarathushtra among the Zarathushtis of Quebec and to others who may wish to learn the teachings of Prophet Zarathushtra, and the scriptures, and to facilitate the performance of all religious ceremonies and the celebration of Zarathushti feasts

Z oroastrians Zoroaster (

Zoroastrianism, founded in 1500 BCE, by prophet Zarathushtra, in Central Asia, is one of the oldest monotheistic religions, which flourished through the rise and fall of many civilizations. It was the state religion of the Great Persian Empire founded by Cyrus the great (558 BCE) who gave the world the First declaration of Human Rights, inscribed on the Cyrus Cylinder, freed the Jews from Babylonian captivity and allowed them to rebuild their temple in Jerusalem. The Persians were conquered by Alexander who destroyed the Zoroastrian scriptures with the burning of Persepolis. Zoroastrianism again flourished under the Sasanian empire (226 CE-641 CE). With the advent of Islam and the conquest of Persia by the Arabs, Zoroastrians struggled to survive, many were forced to convert, many left for India where they are called the Parsis and many stayed in Iran holding on to their faith and preserving amongst much hardship.

The Zoroastrian Religion has had more influence on mankind, directly or indirectly, than any other single faith ... its leading doctrines were adopted by Judaism, Christianity and Islam. Concepts like Belief in One Supreme God Ahura Mazda, Heaven and Hell and individual judgement, ultimate triumph of good over evil, freedom of choice, are all Zoroastrian concepts. It is an ecological religion believing in the stewardship of the environment and proctecting it with great reverence.



In Iran, in spite of religious persecution, the Zoroastrians played a significant role in the social development of Iran. Zoroastrian entrepreneurs were the first to introduce English and sports in schools, Jamshid Jamshidian introduced modern banking, Esfandiar Yeganegi introduced modern irrigation, Farhang Mehr, was the President of Pahlavi University in Shiraz, founder of the Central Insurance Company and later appointed General Deputy Minister, Keikhosrow Shahrokh had a major role in changing the official Islamic calendar to the current Iranian civil calendar, Farangis Yeganegi was the founder and Director of Iranian Handicrafts Organization. They all enriched the community with their vision and knowledge.

In India, notable Zoroastrians nationally and internationally are Rohinton Mistry, the celebrated Canadian author, Zubin Mehta the internationally renowned Conductor, late Freddy Mercury of the famed band, Queen and the Zoroastrian Companies such as the House of Tatas, manufacturer of Tetley Tea, Jaguar Cars and Land Rover S.U.Vs. who have also made munificent donations to Universities in North America.

After centuries of separation of Parsis and Iranian Zoroastrians, they are now united again in North America where they have formed a vibrant community contributing to the Canadian and Quebec multicultural fabric of Society.



ERVAD GEV PESY KARKARIA

Ervad Gev was born in Bombay on February 6th, 1943. After completing his schooling at St Theresa High School and Bharda New High School, he obtained his CA from India. Born in a priestly family, he completed his navar training in Navsari, and was ordained as a priest at the age of 12.

Before immigrating to Canada in 1975, Gev worked in India as an accountant with Air India. He has lived in Montreal, and became a Canadian citizen in 1980. He worked as an accountant and was vice-president at Wirth Steel in Montreal for over 35 years.



Gev is widely admired in the community, by his former co-workers, family and friends for his calm demeanor and honest, quiet leadership. He has dedicated countless hours to the Zoroastrian community in Quebec and beyond the province, performing jashans, navjotes, weddings and funerals in Montreal and across North America. Most recently, he proudly co-performed the navjote of his grandson last year along with his son Zal, also a mobed.

Gev is married to Shirine Motafaram, his staunch supporter in all his community work for 44 years. They have two children and four grand children, son Zal working for the Canadian Government, lives in London, with his wife and two children and daughter Zia, a social worker, who now lives in Ireland with her husband and two children.

Gev has always been very active in the Community. Since 1977, he has been the Treasurer, committee member and then president from 1997-2001. He was the Treasurer of the NAMC from 2002-2009 and secretary from 2010-2015, always actively participating in a variety of topics discussed at the meetings.

Gev is the backbone of the community, looking after their religious and social needs, always ready to help people in need and offering his services for filling tax returns, driving people to hospital for appointments, helping solve family issues, etc. We have never heard Gev say NO to any request for help.

The Zoroastrian Community is very grateful and we recognize his contribution with this small token of our gratitude.



Ervad JAL M. PANTHAKI

Jal was born in Bombay on 22 Nov. 1933 to Bachu and Minocher Panthaki

After completing his schooling at St. Xavier High School he graduated in science from Sidharth College in Bombay .

At the age of 12 he was ordained as a priest after completing his training as a navar and a martab in Navsari. Even with his university studies he performed religious ceremonies during the muktad days at the agiary and assisted at various jashans, navjotes and weddings.



During his university days he had a distinguished career in National Cadet Corps as Sr. Under Officer- Cadet Adjutant-representing Bombay at the Republic Parade in New Delhi.

He was selected for Dehra Dun Military College, but had to resign because of his weak eye sight.

In India Jal joined TATA Textiles, and was sent for Practical & Executive Training to England, France, Germany & Switzerland. He was also sent to the United States where he worked in New Hampshire and in New Jersey to learn American methods. In India he worked in several different positions in Tata Mills, Swadeshi Mills, Ahmedabad Advance Mills and finally In Nagpur Empress Mills as Processing Manager. Jal married his childhood sweetheart Dr Nergish in 1961 and they left for Canada in 1972 with their son Zubin who is a plastic surgeon and lives in Miami, with his wife and three children.

In Canada, Jal joined Rayonese Textile in St. Jerome, Quebec as Chief Chemist & Processing Manager, retiring in 2005, with honors as a Senior Executive of Rayonese-Culp, a U.S.A. Company.

Jal has been very active in the Montreal community serving the religious needs of members, performing rituals for death ceremonies, weddings, initiation into the religion (navjote /sudreh pushi) ceremonies, community and house jashans, visiting and comforting the sick and helping with their transport.

Jal is always ready to respond to any request for religious ceremonies for all members of the community.

Jal has served as an Executive Committee member of ZAQ for 2 terms.





Jainism:

Jainism is the religion of about ten million people in India, with its own distinctive scriptures, history, and a long philosophic tradition. Although a part of greater Indian culture, Jainism, like Buddhism, is a non-vedic religious tradition. Noted for its rigorous asceticism, Jain thought has influenced the greater Indian culture especially through its doctrine of ahimsa, non-injury to all living beings.

Jainism teaches a strict doctrine of karma, which binds a person to suffer rebirth and retribution for all evil actions. A person must therefore liberate himself or herself from the fetters of karma by taking a vow of asceticism and therefore avoiding all violence in deed, in word, and in thought.

All passionate desire begets violence, and is itself the result of the karma of a deluded consciousness which must be eliminated. According to Jainism each person has within himself or herself the potential to realize perfection and become Paramatman, a soul freed from all karmic fetters and able to reach the highest point in the universe.

The wise man looks upon life as a mere dew drop which quivers upon the tip of a blade of kusa grass, to be whisked off or blown away by the breeze at any moment. The life of an unwise, imprudent, and ignorant person is likewise as transient as said dew drop.
